DID YOU KNOW

No written grievance shall be considered at Stage II unless forwarded within (30) school days after the employee/Union knew or should have known of the act or condition on which the grievance is based.

If you think you have a grievance or that the District is in violation of our contract please contact your Union Rep ASAP as there are time limits for us to deal with.

NOTES FROM THE PRESIDENT

We have successfully settled both I.P.s. One for Sub-contracting and one for Direct Dealing. We have also settled the second of three (3) grievances. Back pay for employees working in Aide and Monitor positions who worked extra time beyond their regularly scheduled hours during the pandemic. The third grievance is currently at Stage V and we are waiting for a response. We will keep you posted on the status.

Matt Miller has been continuing on the website. In addition to all the NYSUT and AFT news you will now start seeing our newsletters and Matt will be inserting all back issues. Our contact information has been added and we will be listing all our Reps next. As soon as I get a PDF of our by-laws they will be added. In the future, after we negotiate a new contract that will also be added.

Negotiations: We met on the 4th of May and this was a good and productive meeting. We will be meeting again on the 24th. The Negotiating team has given me permission to meet with Mary Mandel to find common ground on several of the demands we have. We have decided to do this to help expedite this process so that we may have a contract by years end. I was successful in doing this the last time we negotiated a contract and hopefully we can be successful again.

We are having great turnouts at our monthly meetings. Last month we heard from 2 BOE (Board of Education) candidates and this month we will hear from 3 more. So please attend our meeting and hear their platform and ask questions. I will be asking the Reps after the meeting for endorsements. The Teachers Association have already endorsed their candidates. If we endorse the same ones we can send a message to the district should we be able to turn this Board over. We can institute change, our voices will be heard but we all need to stand up and make it happen.

We now have a new Building Rep at the High School, Tom Levanti. For those who work at the High School, should you need anything, please contact Tom. If he can't answer your question he will get the answer from us. Thank you, Tom, for stepping up!!!!! Mark Mitchell has stepped up to be the custodial/cleaner rep. He works at the High School. Thank you Mark for stepping up!!!!! All Rep positions are now filled. I believe this is a first since I've been here! Thank you all for being a part of this union! I see more and more members becoming involved. This shows that we are getting stronger and more unified. We continue to accept members for committee assignments should you be interested.
