NOTES FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Member,

We are now handing out a packet with a copy of our old by-laws and a copy of our new proposed by-laws. The new proposed by-laws are updated and conform with rules and regulations according to the Labor - Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). It also parallels NYSUT's Campaign & Elections Procedure.

There are several conflicting issues in our old by-laws. For example; the old set of by-laws state that our fiscal year runs from Sept. 1 to Aug. 30. This was changed in 2013 by past leadership to July 1 to June 30 but was never amended in our by-laws.

The proposed set of by-laws will give clarity to all members of their rights; and addresses more clearly the responsibilities of the officers duly elected to represent the membership.

Please read both carefully and come to our next meeting on March 10th with questions or concerns. We will be voting by secret ballot on March 16th. Each building will have a sign in sheet with a ballot for each member.

The by-law committee has put some time in to review and address all issues. They now recommend the passing of these proposed new by-laws.

Finally, let me say that we are finalizing our order for T-shirts or sweat shirts. If you haven't submitted a member contact sheet, please do so or you will not be able to get either of the shirts. Should you want a sweat shirt you will pay the difference between the two, the T-shirt is free.
